A powerpoint presentation was shown with slides to accompany the agenda points and chairman's report.

- 1. **Welcome, apologies and introduction by Graham Forsyth.** Graham introduced the board members and explained the format of the AGM, including voting of the board.
- **2. Approval of previous minutes.** Previous AGM minutes were circulated and proposed by Andy Pointer and seconded by Chris Birt.
- 3. Chair's Report (Powerpoint attached). The report was received, approved and seconded
 - Graham Forsyth gave a brief background to the Trust, including how it is structured and operates
 - Aims and objectives were described and how we will achieve these objectives
 - ADT works in partnership with Perth & Kinross Council, Communities Housing Trust,
 Development Trusts Association of Scotland and local community councils.
 - The Aberfeldy site has been purchased by ADT using our £125,000 award from SLF for Stage 2. Pre-application planning has been submitted to PKC and we are hosting a Community Consultation on the 8th November to gain input from our community before submitting our final planning application.
 - We were successful in securing a £200,000 grant from the SSE Renewables Griffin and Calliachar Community Fund to support the building of new community-owned affordable homes in Aberfeldy.
 - o The 5-year Community Action Plan for Aberfeldy and surrounding areas was published, bringing together existing community organisations to work together to deliver the CAP process. The CAP represents 557 community views surveys, from over 1,200 households. 25 stakeholder meetings were held, and 26 businesses contributed their views. 282 people attended our Community Futures Event.
 - O ADT submitted our draft Local Place Plan to Perth and Kinross Council.
 - O ADT instigated a meeting with the Convenor of Perth & Kinross Council's Housing and Social Wellbeing Committee to discuss our concerns regarding the lack of affordable housing in Highland Perthshire. We brought together neighbouring development trusts in Highland Perthshire as part of the process to represent the widest constituency and amplify the concerns of our communities.
